CURRENT PROJECTS:

North Cornwall Wind Farm Co-operative - A group of farmers are forming a wind farm co-op. Each farmer will have 2 wind turbines. The planning process has taken time but all now have planning consent. The grant bodies are interested in the project as it demonstrates how energy can be generated and sold collectively. We are preparing the grant applications and putting together the financial package to fund the project.



Black Barn Carbon Neutral Wedding Venue - A farm diversification project to create a wedding venue that is a net producer of energy and can be marketed as 'carbon neutral'. We provided estimates of the annual energy demand of the new building, calculated the project's potential carbon footprint and undertook an energy efficiency audit. We also made a full assessment of technologies that would meet requirements and the viability of other options such as rainwater harvesting and sustainable building materials. After finalising plans we undertook a grant search, wrote a successful funding application to the LEADER scheme and sourced local contractors for the client.

Anaerobic digesters - Currently we are working on several anaerobic digesters varying in size. The largest is being submitted in the North West with a capital investment of £2.5 million. The crop needs to supply this system will be contracted out to the surrounding farmers. We have developed a bespoke package that can guide land owners and farmers from conception to development.
